Suggested Action

- Contact boat owners to correct the Hull ID numbers and find the typos in the MIC.
- Issue standard format Hull ID numbers to those boats that have numeric HINs.
- Where a VIN was entered instead of a Hull ID, check if a trailer or other vehicle.
- Resolve the duplicate Hull ID numbers and investigate HIN-Cloning fraud
- Replace the State Registration numbers, IMOs, and ENIs with the correct HIN and track this ID in another field separately.
